## TREES OF EDEN - PARADISE

The elegant Trees of Eden panels are an ode to the eponymous, mythological garden of paradise. Their design takes its inspiration from archive chintz patterns from the early 17th-19th centuries, where the fusion of ethnic motifs and traditional British heritage design created opulent and highly-prized textiles.

Each tree, whilst different in design, depicts boughs luxuriant in foliage. **Eternity**, with its lush boughs of willowy branches, derives its name from the abundant wisteria flowers in full bloom, symbolising both youthful vitality and devotion. **Paradise**, whilst unequivocally associated with the Garden of Eden, is also Persian in its origin and refers to a 'royal garden', reflected in the lavish flora adorning the climbing tendrils. The trio is completed by **Life**, perhaps the most famous of Eden's trees, sitting resplendent with a canopy of budding fruits.

The sumptuous parchment-style ground paper and complementary semi-plain Eden Stripe surrounding the print's frame, make the hand-rendered, charcoal motif more a piece of art than wallpaper. Each tree's design is unique and painted to scale, with a distressed, batik-like effect making this highly decorative series an instant design statement. The panels can be hung side by side for dramatic effect or individually for a striking centrepiece.

### HANGING INSTRUCTIONS – PARADISE

**Trees of Eden - Paradise** is supplied and printed as one continuous roll of wallpaper measuring 70cm in width and 400cm in length. For ease of hanging, the panel can be trimmed from the top and bottom to suit any wall height, with 100cm of Eden Stripe below the panel and 129cm of Eden Stripe above panel.
